



How it Works

We have built a safe, interactive and fun fundraising site where your child can get involved in the MS Readathon.

We understand that your child's privacy and online safety is paramount for you which is why we ask you to sign your children up.

Once registered, your child will have their own profile and fundraising page (managed by you) on the site and can choose and design an avatar, win virtual awards, enter competitions, get sponsorship, win amazing prizes and, rate and review books.

All their fundraising is done through this website, so the funds come directly to us at MS Ireland.

Your child's profile appears on the site in the form of a cartoon avatar with their name alongside it. Once registered you can choose an alternate or nickname for your child if you'd prefer (just be sure to let potential sponsors know what it is!)

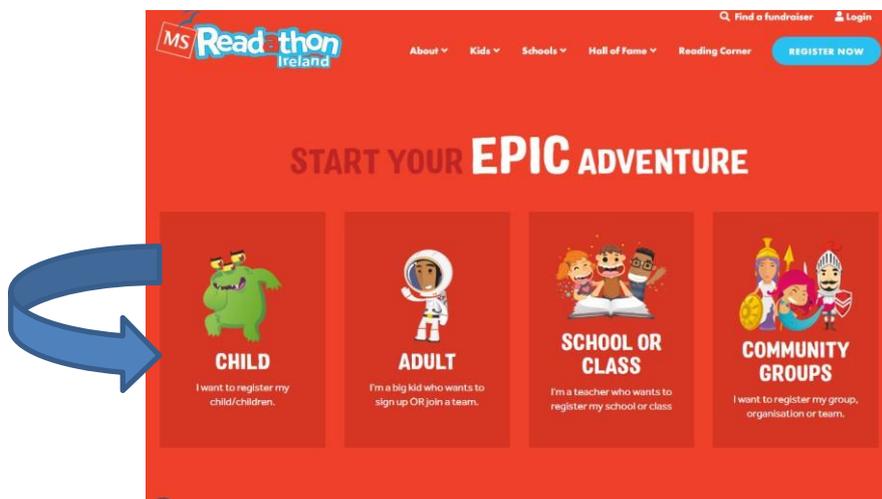
If your child is taking part with their school and you have linked their profile up to the school's fundraising page, anything your child raises will automatically be added to the class and school total.

So Let's Get Signed Up

1. Select the 'Register Now' button



2. Select Child



3. Parents complete their own details first then hit the 'Next Step' button

4. Parents fill out the Child's correct name and details (if doing so - you can add an alternate nickname at a later stage)

5. If your child is taking part with their school type in the school roll number and select the school. If you don't have the roll number start typing part of the name of the school – e.g. if your child attends St. Mary's start typing Mary and a list of schools will populate)

9. Choose Avatar

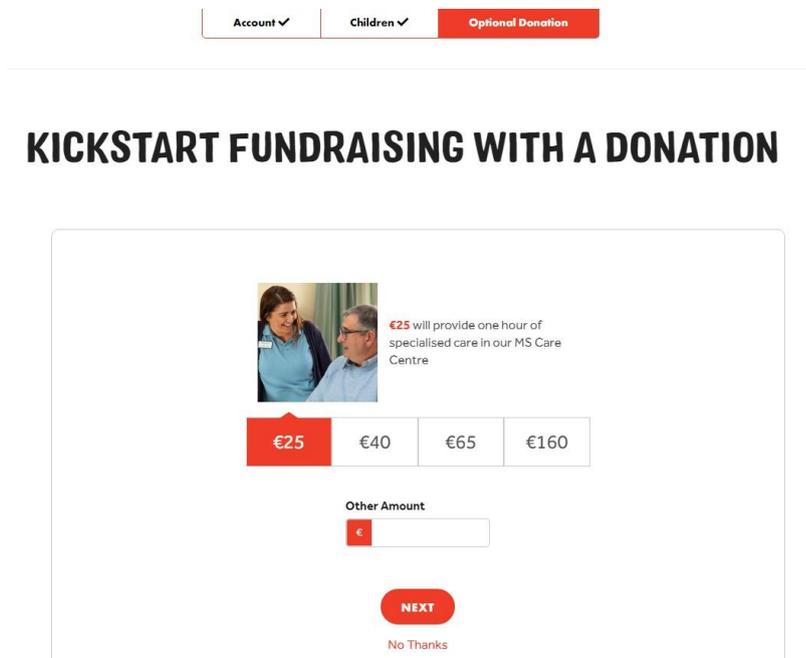
